International registrations will only be processed after receipt of the payment. Late entries are possible till two hours before the beginning of each event. Late entry fee € 20,-- for each event.

The registration office for the hammer throw will be located directly at the competition area and will be available in good time before the start of the event.

The final confirmation has to be completed in person no later than 75 minutes before the start of the competition by properly checking off the registration list at the registration desk. Failure to confirm will result in the cancellation of the respective competition.

Venue: 8 line tartan venue, maximum spike length 6mm

Own implements: Are allowed due to the rules of Austrian Athletics. They will be delivered to the venue after implements control.

Throwers warm up: Directly at the venue.

IMPLEMENTING PROVISIONS

1. The competitions will be carried out due to the rules of Austrian Athletics, World Athletics and World Masters Athletics.
2. The year of birth dedicates the age group.
3. Walking in running competitions will lead to immediate disqualification, IWR TR 4.4.3 (WA Competition and Technical Rules 4.4.3)!
4. We will not enforce the World Athletics Shoes Rule (TR5) at this Championship, because the results achieved during these Championships will not have relevance for the Global Calendar or the World Ranking (Elite Class).
5. In all age groups in the technical events, international athletes are not guaranteed a place in the finals, but if a technical event is not fully booked, the number of finalists will be filled.
6. Trial attempts will be made according to the start list; a maximum of 3 trial attempts per athlete are permitted (shot put, long jump, discus, javelin, hammer).
7. No medal standards are required.

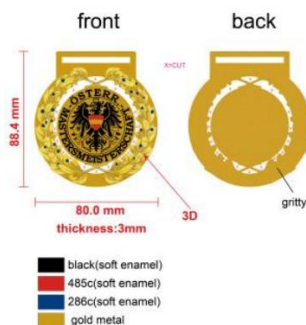

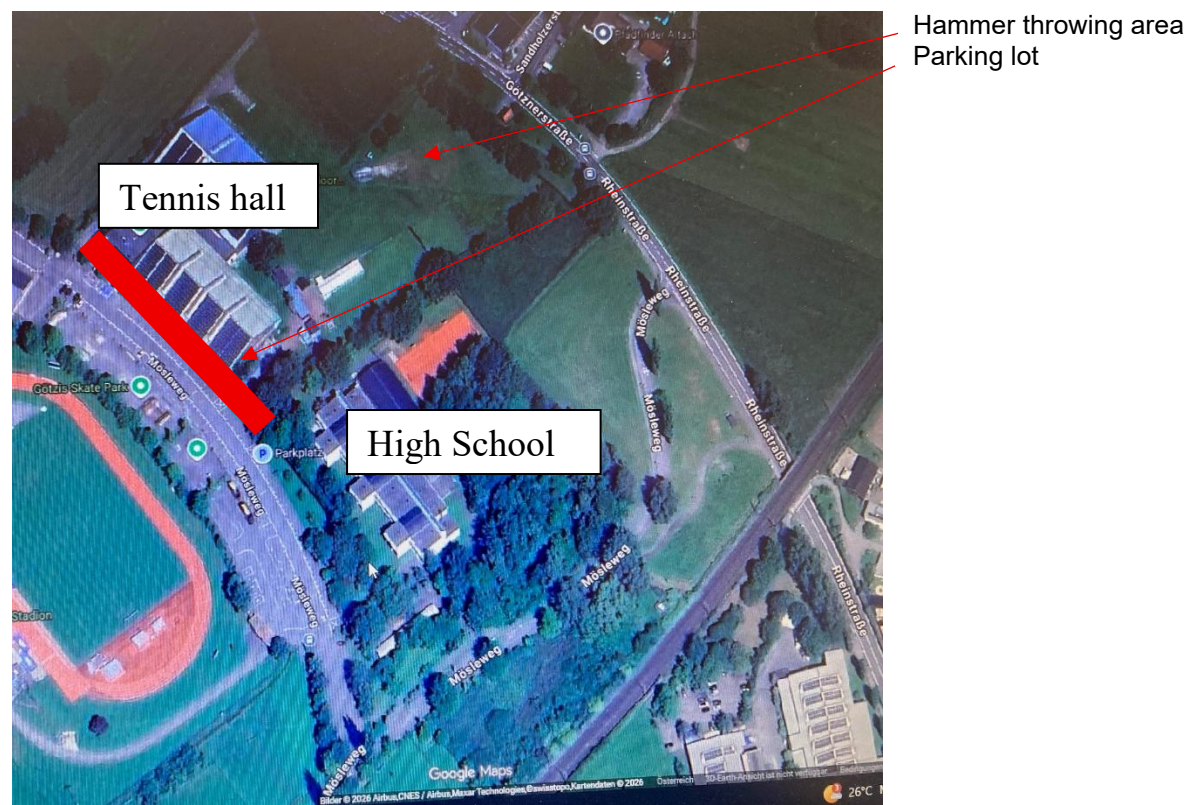

Purposes of Processing

The purposes of processing are the preparation and execution of the event, such as administration of registrations, creation and maintenance of start and participant lists, evaluation of performances for the preparation of result lists, publication of results and reports, as well as press and public relations activities.

Legal Bases

The legal bases for these processing activities are primarily the performance of a contract pursuant to Art. 6(1)(b) GDPR, compliance with legal obligations pursuant to Art. 6(1)(c) GDPR (e.g. the Austrian Federal Fiscal Code and regional tax laws), and, in individual cases, our legitimate interests pursuant to Art. 6(1)(f) GDPR.

Legitimate Interests

Our legitimate interests pursuant to Art. 6(1)(f) GDPR lie in enabling the organization and execution of the event within the scope of our statutory duties and purposes as an association. Within the framework of legitimate interests, we document the event, for example through photographs and reports, and publish these on our website.

Processing based on legitimate interests is carried out only after careful balancing of our interests with the interests of the data subjects. We comply with all data protection regulations and ensure the protection of the rights and interests of the data subjects. If you believe that your rights and/or interests are violated or restricted by our data processing activities, please inform us; we will discontinue further processing wherever possible without delay.

Recipients or Categories of Recipients

For the purposes stated above, we may transfer personal data of data subjects to commissioned third parties who act on our behalf to fulfill these purposes (e.g. IT service providers, media services and media companies for press and public relations activities, timekeeping companies, etc.). Data are not transferred to third countries or international organizations.

Storage Period / Criteria for Determining the Storage Period

We store and process data for the period resulting from the respective type of processing. We ensure that data are stored only for as long as necessary to fulfill the stated purposes.

Rights of Data Subjects

You have the right to access, rectification, erasure, restriction of processing, in certain cases the right to object to processing, as well as the right to data portability.
